The placement of chock blocks and trailer tires would be included in the lessons, in addition to lessons on the arrangement of pallets to distribute the load correctly, and inspections needed before driving into a trailer at a dock site. MSDS or likewise known as Material Safety Data Sheet training is also included in the course. Though not related directly to the operation of a lift truck, MSDS training is important in case an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on individuals and proper ways of dealing with spills.
